Re: Update on Industrial Action by the NUT on Wednesday, 26 March 2014

Further to my letter of 13 March 2014 in which I informed you of Industrial Action to be taken by members of the NUT on Wednesday 26 March 2014 in relation to their concerns over the ongoing changes to their pay, work conditions and pensions proposed by the government, I write to confirm that Heston Community School will be closed to all students on Wednesday, 26 March 2014, with the exception of Sixth Form students in the classes listed below who should come to School to attend the lessons listed below.
