Black and British: A Forgotten History - David Olusoga. Recommended by Mrs Nandra, a thought provoking and interesting look at Black British History.

The Making of a Moonie - Eileen Barker

Twopence to Cross the Mersey: the story of a Liverpool childhood that will break your heart - Helen Forrester. Recommended by Mrs Nandra an excellent and relatively easy read that looks at Forrester's experiences after her father went bankrupt in 1930 and her family went from being Upper class with wealth and servants to living in extreme poverty.
