## REMINDERS FOR THE NEW ACADEMIC YEAR STARTING SEPTEMBER 2025

- Smart Watches [e.g. Apple Watches, Fitbits etc] are no longer allowed on site
- Acrylic nails, false eye lashes, jewellery or additional piercing other than one small stud in ear, are prohibited
- Please download the Heston Community School App and Trackit Lights if you have not already done so. Both are critical for communication
- The Heston Community School App is the only way parents can report a student's absence from September
- Please be aware of the new national framework on absences. Fines of £160 for students having 10 sessions [5 days] unauthorised absences
- Term time leave would usually be regarded as an unauthorised absence and will now almost certainly lead to LA fines being imposed
- Equipment lists have been provided in previous letters; but we encourage parents to replace old calculators with the Casio FX-83GTCW as this benefit students in Maths and Science

During the summer we would appreciate parents reviewing student's uniform and updating where necessary; uniform requirements are listed on the [website](#) and available from [School Bells](#).

- Shirts need to be long enough so that they can be tucked in to trousers and skirts, and to allow for top buttons to be fastened comfortably for the clip-on tie to work
- Ties need to be undamaged with all stitching intact
- Black belts can be worn by students to allow trousers to fit better
- Students should wear shoes not trainers
