## UNIFORM

There are a number of changes to the Heston Community School Uniform for the new academic year. We believe that students fulfilling their commitment to wear their uniform correctly and with pride leads to the development of positive attitudes towards their learning. The full Uniform Code is available on our website and is also in the Student Planner/Diary. Sixth Form students are required to wear **formal business dress** as per the Sixth Form Student Hand Book.

Safety, dress, punctuality, attendance and the highest standards are important to all of us. We all want to start each day positively so please help us in September by ensuring your child leaves home appropriately and smartly dressed for learning. To start the day positively we are also requesting that all students are on site by 08:20 every day.

### SCHOOL UNIFORM

#### STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR UNIFORM TO, FROM AND AT SCHOOL

- School tie
- School blazer with School Logo
- Plain black skirt [knee length]
- Plain black trousers [regular cut] - no jeans or tight fitting trousers
- Plain white shirt
- Black V-necked pullover with School Logo
- Black leather type upper shoes
- White or black socks
- Plain black or flesh coloured tights
- Plain black outdoor coat, hat and scarf – no logos or stripes
- No caps or hoodies
- Plain black or white Hijab/Turban

#### STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR THE FOLLOWING PE KIT AT SCHOOL

- Black and red School rugby shirt
- White School T-shirt with School logo
- Black School shorts with School logo **and** black tracksuit bottoms with School Logo
- Black football socks
- Shin pads for matches
- Supportive trainers [not plimsolls]
- Football boots / Astro-turf trainers [optional]

In response to some parent's request for further guidance when purchasing uniform we have added the following clarification and request that all parents and students familiarise themselves with the expected dress code of the School.

<b>Uniform Item</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Further Clarification</b>
<b>Blazer</b>	Black with the Heston Badge	Compulsory - it is to be worn at all times unless given permission by a teacher
<b>Tie</b>	Heston School clip on striped tie	Ties must cover the top button on the shirt
<b>Shirt</b>	Plain white and able to accommodate a tie and have a top button which fastens	Shirts must be sufficiently generous to tuck fully into the skirt/trousers The top button must be done up and shirts must be tucked in
<b>Trousers</b>	Plain black, straight cut trousers sufficiently tailored to keep the shirt tucked in	Trousers must not be skin-tight or boot cut and must have a natural hang Any belt worn should be plain black and without large buckles
<b>Skirt</b>	Black formal - at least knee length	Skirts must be formal with no slits; fitted or tight skirts of a stretchy material are not permitted
<b>Jumper</b>	Heston black V neck jumper with School logo	The jumper is optional; it cannot be worn in place of a blazer
<b>Shoes</b>	Smart black, plain and polishable	Velcro fastening shoes, ballerina pumps, trainer style shoes, canvas style footwear, boots and 'kickers' are not permitted as they are not formal school footwear
<b>Scarf and Gloves</b>	Must be plain black	
<b>Outdoor coats</b>	Must be plain black	Leather jackets or sports jackets including 'hoodies' are not permitted
<b>Hair</b>	Hair bands, ribbons, clips and any other item used in the hair should be plain black Plain black or white hijabs or turbans are permitted	Haircuts must be grade 2 or above. No shaved designs or lines are allowed in hair or eyebrows Dyed hair of any type or any extreme high fashion haircuts are not permitted
<b>Jewellery</b>	One small single plain stud earring maybe worn in each ear lobe Rings, necklaces and bracelets must not be worn	No other piercing is acceptable Excuses that they cannot be taken out because they have only just been done will not be accepted and students will be instructed to remove them
<b>Make up</b>	Make up of any form is not permitted	Artificial nails or nail varnish are not permitted and students will be instructed to remove them
<b>Bags</b>	These should be big enough to hold equipment and school books up to A4 size	Handbags are not appropriate for school equipment
<b>Students should expect detentions or confiscation of an item if they wear the uniform incorrectly.</b>
