COVID-19 vaccination for children aged 12 to 15 years of age

I am writing to inform you that we are offering COVID-19 vaccinations at Heston Community School on **Wednesday 13 October – Friday 15 October**.

I would like to ask if you wish to give your consent for your child to receive a first dose of the vaccine.

This vaccination will be free of charge and our highest priority is making it easy for children to access one dose of the vaccine before the winter.

The main purpose of the COVID-19 school age vaccination programme is to provide protection to the children who receive the vaccine and may help to reduce transmission of COVID-19 in the wider population. During the vaccination delivery we will maintain the range of measures we have in place to keep you safe from COVID-19.

If your child is 11 years old, they will not be able to be vaccinated at this time. If your child is older than 15, but has not been vaccinated, they are welcome to be vaccinated at School. Please complete the Google Form.
