It is with concern that we write once again about the actions of a few parents who are putting our young people and community at risk. Early this week, there was a road traffic accident during which one of our students was hurt. Fortunately, on this occasion, the result was bruises and soreness, which will heal relatively quickly.

Over the last week, the following issues have been observed, each one increasing the likelihood of an accident.


- Allowing passengers to exit cars in slow moving traffic or while lights are red
- Pulling over to the pavement directly in-front of the School to allow passengers to disembark – usually with no regard for cyclists
- Performing three-point turns directly in-front of the School
- Parking on zig-zag lines next to the pelican crossing
- Attempting to drive onto site
- Dropping students off in front of the School gates.

The regulations for cars on our roads tend to be understood by all. At times, they create inconvenience and delays. However, they are there for all our safety. We would urge the few parents who are putting our students in danger to stop these practices and help the School maintain a safe environment.
