Dear Parent/Carer

Following the recent changes to the Government advice on 'Living with Covid-19', we would like to clarify the actions you will need to take if your child is unwell with Covid-19.

If your child tests positive for Covid-19, with a Lateral Flow or PCR test, they should not attend school for a minimum of three days. The day of the test is referred to as Day 0. Your child should only return to school if they do not have a high temperature, above 38°C.

If someone in your household tests positive, your child may still attend school, however, we request that they wear a mask and remain vigilant to the signs and symptoms, to limit the spread of infection.
